The AUSTROS will be held as part of the ANZ REIA 100 event, scheduled to take place from May 14 to May 16, 2024, in Hobart, Tasmania. This prestigious gathering, organised in collaboration with the Real Estate Institute of Tasmania (REIT), will bring together industry professionals from across Australia to participate in a series of events, including the AUSTROS, the REIA National Awards for Excellence, and the REIA Centennial Congress.

"Congratulations to our AUSTROS 2024 finalists."


